WHAT ARE THE DATES FOR WILDFIRE!?

July 9-14, 2017

HOW MANY SPONSORS PER STUDENT ARE NEEDED?

We suggest at least one adult per 6 youth

AGES: WHO IS IT FOR?

Wildfire! is for youth grades 6-12 (grade they are entering in the fall). Jr. High/Middle School youth are grades 6-8; Sr. High youth are grades 9-12.

Cost

The fee is \$135 per participant. This fee covers all onsite trip expenses including meals.

There is a deposit of \$50 per participant that is due by June 1.

REGISTRATION

- Do adults need to pay?
 Yes. Every participant needs to pay.
- Do you need registration packets for adults?
 Yes. Every participant needs to complete a packet. There are separate packets for youth and for adults.
- 3. How does a church or youth group register?
 The registration process begins with completing a Church Registration Form
 (available online at superiorfaithumc.org). This will reserve space for your group.
 Send this form with a deposit to Faith United Methodist Church by June 1. The
 deposit is \$50 per participant. Then have each participant complete a registration
 packet. (You will notice there is a separate registration packet for youth and for
 adults.) If you have completed registration packets for participants ready at this time,
 you can send them along with the deposit.
- 4. What is the deadline to send in final payment and registration packets?
 We would like to receive all the registration packets and final payment by June 19.

- 5. Can we register another youth after the June 1 deadline?
 Yes, as long as there is space available, you can register additional youth. Contact us for availability.
- 6. College-age students—are they listed as adults or youth? According to Safe Sanctuaries, adults need to be 5 years older than the oldest youth to be considered an adult chaperone. If the oldest youth is age 18, then 5 years older would be age 23 or older. If the oldest youth is middle school age, then an adult age 21 could be registered as an adult chaperone.

Housing

1. Where will we be staying?

We have made sleeping arrangements with another church a couple blocks away; the men will be staying in one part of the building and the women will be staying in another part of the building. You will be sleeping on the floor so bring an air mattress, fans, etc, to make your stay more comfortable!

2. Will showers be available?

Yes, usually we use the showers at the University of Wisconsin-Superior Wellness Center. These are group showers, so if you prefer to wear a bathing suit while you are showering, that is okay. Adults—you have the option to use the showers at Faith Church.

WHAT TO BRING:

Comfortable, modest, casual clothes for the entire week; work gloves; towel; washcloth; personal toiletries; sleeping bag; pillow; sleeping clothes; fans; air mattress; swimwear; light jacket; pen; Bible; notebook; alarm clock; insect repellent; sun screen; spending money; a positive attitude and willingness to be flexible.

START TIME / END TIME:

The Wildfire! schedule begins at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday; feel free to arrive anytime in the afternoon on Sunday. The trip concludes mid-morning Friday (you will be on the road before noon).
